Mary Jones Scholarship**

Eligibility Guidelines, Application Criteria and Instructions

Two (2) scholarships of up to \$1,000 each are available to be awarded twice each year. Once for the upcoming fall semester during the spring and again in the fall semester for the spring semester.

The scholarship shall be used solely for post-secondary educational purposes. This includes part-time, full-time, academic and vocational studies. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing a certificate or degree program.

Required Submissions:

1. Complete application.

2. Essay.

Describe your educational goals and objectives, your employment history, your plans and time frame for meeting these goals, and you plans for utilizing your education after you receive your degree. Explain how your education will benefit the Native Community. The essay must be type written. This essay is very important and may not be a duplicate essay from a previous year.

3. Two brief letters of recommendation from responsible adult persons, not related to the applicant.

Two letters of reference are required, preferably from a previous teacher(s), employer(s), minister(s), or other professional person(s) not related to the applicant. Letters of reference may **NOT** be delivered by the applicant. They may **NOT** be a duplicate from a previous year.

4. Copy of Sealed high school or college transcripts. Copies of online transcripts are not acceptable.

The scholarship committee will use a number of criteria to evaluate and rate the applications including:

1. Proof of current membership in ANB/ANS Camp 14 Ketchikan,
2. Enrollment in credit bearing classes,
3. Current School Sealed Students Transcripts showing GPA,
4. Demonstrated financial need
5. Preference will be given to full time students and to applicants who are active in Camp 14 or a camp 14 members's family member seeking an application. Activity in the camp is defined as attending meetings and/or assisting with fundraisers and other functions and being a member of good standing.

Deadline: Completed application must be postmarked by April 20 of the calendar year for the fall scholarship.

Applications must be postmarked by October 20 for the following spring scholarship.
